- b) Help to serve where needed.
- c) Parents—watch all children carefully so that no problems will occur. Parents must be in control of their children at all times.
- d) Take as much food as you want—but eat all you take. No waste!
- e) Be certain to pick up all belongings after services and take them to your car. Pick up after vour children.
- f) Have children take notes during services.
- g) Respect this property. It belongs to Yahweh.
- h) Do not walk on public roads; stay within Yahweh's property.
- i) Volunteer help would be appreciated during the Feast.
- i) We continue to notice an excessive amount of going to the bathrooms and movement during prayers. Please plan ahead.
- k) Keep all restroom facilities clean!
- During this spring sacred season, when the various flu viruses may still be circulating, sometimes at epidemic proportions, each individual who has the flu should guarantine himself/herself from the congregation. For those who suspect that they may be coming down with a virus, only shake hands when greeting the brethren. Do not greet anyone with a holy kiss! Purell is available for everyone to cleanse their hands.
- Again, we welcome all of the brethren, visitors, and people of good will. The Bethel Assembly is thankful you have come to worship with us, and if you need assistance of any kind, please ask the ushers.
